>>> A MESSAGE FROM OUR FIRE CHIEF

Outdoor grill fires are responsible for over 8,000 fires annually in the United States, with the greatest percentage occurring in July. This results in \$75 million in property damage annually.

STEPS TO ENSURE SAFE FUN:

- -Always make sure your grill is clear of debris and grease build up.
- -Keep grills at least 5 feet from your home or other structures.
- -Never use your grill under eaves or other overhangs

WATER SAFETY TIPS

>>> IMPORTANT!

Follow some of these quick and easy tips to stay cool and safe when enjoying Lock Haven's water facilities this summer:

- Check with local organizations such as the YMCA or American Red Cross to find swim lessons if you don't know how to properly swim.
- Never swim alone.
- Supervise children when they are near bodies of water, particularly children under 5 years of age who are at greatest risk for drowning.
- Wear a flotation jacket if you're unsure of your swimming ability.
- If you experience a near-drowning incident that involves inhalation of water, this is still a medical emergency and care from a healthcare professional is needed!


