FIRE SAFETY TIPS FROM OUR FIRE CHIEF

>>> SPRING CLEANING TO PREVENT FIRES!

-Clear dead vegetation such as leaves, brush, and pine needles from around your home.

-Be sure to properly maintain and inspect outdoor equipment such as lawnmowers and grills before their use. Accumulation of debris in these items over the fall and winter can pose a fire hazard.

-With warmer weather, now is a perfect time to clean out your clothes dryer vent to ensure it's unobstructed and clear of lint!

➤➤➤ NOTICE OF FLUSHING SCHEDULE

The City of Lock Haven Water Department will be flushing and flow testing the water distribution system in accordance with the following schedule:

April 1-10 in Wayne Township

April 10-15 in Castanea Township

April 15- May 10th in the City of Lock Haven

Flushing will occur between 7am and 3 pm.

Customers may experience low water pressure and turbidity.



WATER CONSERVATION

➤➤➤ UPDATE ON OUR WATER EMERGENCY

Although Clinton County was removed from Drought status by the PA Department of Environmental Protection, the water system that serves the city and Suburban's customers continues to remain vulnerable due to construction at its Ohi dam. In order to complete the construction, the city had to discharge 36 days' worth of water. Until construction is complete, the system will only have only about 5 months of water capacity in the system, making it still susceptible to draught if there is a lack of rain. An inch of rain is about a day and half of water for the system, but a lack of rainfall will quickly deplete the system, forcing the area back into water restrictions.

For that reason, customers of the city and Suburban are still being asked to voluntarily reduce water use by 10%, about 6-9 gallons a day.

Spending 1 minute less in the shower, capturing water in a pitcher while waiting for the hot water in the kitchen sink, installing a rain barrel to use to water plants... these small steps help conserve the water we all need to live and work in Clinton County. Plus, using less water saves you money because we are all charged for each gallon of water we use. Using less helps us all make sure we have enough water while construction is completed, but it also good for your wallet.

FULL- TIME SEMISKILLED LABORER STARTING AT \$21.86/HR. (\$22.36/HR. AFTER PROBATION PERIOD)

The City of Lock Haven is hiring two Semiskilled Laborer positions in its Department of Public Works. This full-time position starts at \$21.86 per hour and increases to \$22.36 at the end of the probation period. Included are paid holidays, 4 personal days, an allotment of vacation days, plus 8 hours of sick leave per month that can be banked year-to-year as benefits when an accident or illness takes place (like AFLAC). The employee is also eligible for up to \$375 a year in health-related reimbursements. 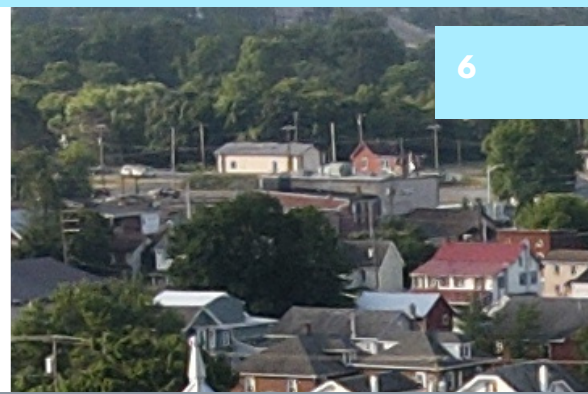
>>> CITY BEACH LIFEGUARD
