

>>> LOCK HAVEN POLICE

The Lock Haven Police Department recently received \$572,000 in grant money from the Local Law Enforcement Support Program. This grant money will provide new radios for Clinton County Sheriff's Dept., CU-Lock Haven, Mill Hall Borough, Pine Creek Township, Renovo Borough, and Woodward Township Police Departments.

The Police have been increasing their efforts to handle traffic related issues in our downtown to make a safer environment for pedestrians. We are also increasing the patrols downtown as well as in parks. If you see an officer, feel free to say hello and get to know our men and women

>>> HOBERMAN SKATEPARK

On November 9, 2023, the City of Lock Haven held a Ribbon Cutting Ceremony for the newly constructed Hoberman Skatepark! The project was a labor of love made possible by many community meetings, design recommendations, and years of collaboration with local skaters and bikers. The skatepark is the first of a multi-phase effort for the redesign of Hoberman Park. Construction will begin later this year, with completion anticipated by the end of 2024.

>>> GLASS AND CARDBOARD

Corrugated cardboard cannot be recycled curbside, but residents can take it to our Recycling Drop-Off Center located at 100 Myrtle Street. The Clinton County Solid Waste Authority is now accepting glass bottles and jars at the Authority's recycling center located on 337 Pine Mountain Road, just past the Restless Oaks Restaurant, in Wayne Township.
