
A MESSAGE FROM OUR POLICE CHIEF

As we get into warmer days, Lock Haven City Police would like to just take a minute to remind everyone about the dangers leaving children and pets in a hot car. A child's body absorbs more heat on a hot day than an adult's body. Heat stroke begins when core body temperature reaches around 104 degrees F. Temperatures inside a car on a 90-degree day can climb to between 120 degrees and 150 degrees in minutes. Pets are also vulnerable to the heat of a car interior, even with the "window cracked". When transporting children or pets in vehicles, make sure you verify that they are all out of the vehicle when you reach your destination. "LOOK BEFORE YOU LOCK!"

FIRE SAFETY TIPS FROM OUR FIRE CHIEF

As summer quickly approaches, a reminder that recreational outdoor fires are allowed within the City of Lock Haven as long as they meet some requirements:

- Must not be larger than 3 feet wide and no higher than 2 feet.
- Must be at least 25 feet from structures.
- Fires must be attended at all times and fire extinguishing equipment available.
- Burning of trash, waste, and yard debris is prohibited.




