

#### >>> WHAT IS SOMETHING YOU WISH RESIDENTS KNEW MORE ABOUT THE POLICE/FIRE DEPARTMENT?

The Fire Department is like owning a business with a 24/7 operation and not getting paid. We rely on community support, so we can keep our operation going.

A FRIENDLY REMINDER FROM THE FIRE COMPANY:

CHAPTER 370 AND 307 PROHIBITS THE BURNING OF TRASH, RUBBISH, OR YARD WASTE WITHIN THE CITY.

RECREATIONAL FIRES
ARE ALLOWED BUT
SHOULDN'T PRODUCE
NUISANCE SMOKE.

RECREATIONAL FIRES MUST BE KEPT
25 FEET FROM COMBUSTIBLE ITEMS
AND MUST NOT BE LARGER THAN 3
FEET WIDE AND 2 FEET IN HEIGHT

AN EXTINGUISHING AGENT, SUCH AS A GARDEN HOSE OR FIRE EXTINGUISHER MUST BE KEPT IN THE AREA.

## DEPARTMENT NEWS

### **CODE ENFORCEMENT**

>>> HOW TO BE A GOOD NEIGHBOR ALL YEAR LONG

A good neighbor clears their sidewalk within 24 hours of snowfall and avoids shoveling snow into the street or blocking sidewalks (City 273, 346).

A good neighbor never litters on the streets, sidewalks, or other public property (City 346).

A good neighbor doesn't let grass or weeds grow taller than 8 inches. A good neighbor doesn't mow grass clippings into the street or alley (City 194,273).

A good neighbor should prevent habitual dog barking, leash their dog in the city and at the park, and clean up after their dog on public and private property (City 182).

A good neighbor ensures all vehicles are licensed, registered, and inspected, and doesn't leave inoperable vehicles on city streets or public parking lots (City 386).

## TRAFFIC SIGNAL IMPROVEMENTS



Bellefonte Avenue (SR 150) -Second Avenue - Barton Street Intersection

Construction crews will be on site working to replace traffic signals and make improvements to the intersection.

Work is expected to occur until August 2025.

## TRANSPORTATION PLAN

The City of Lock Haven was awarded a WalkWorks grant to develop an Active Transportation Plan. This plan will include connections for people walking, biking, using wheelchairs and using transit including a connection to the BEVT through the city. Having a completed plan like this will help prioritize Lock Haven's for future funding for priorities recognized in this plan.

#### BIKE SAFETY EFFORTS

As a reminder, the city has measures in place to ensure the safety of its citizens. As a result, all bikes and motorized or non-motorized vehicles/devices are prohibited on the levee and city sidewalks. Anyone who fails to comply will be subject to a fine.
