Anyone can join a local fire department. Not only does the fire department allow you to create great friendships, you can a significant amount of knowledge through training. I wouldn't be the person I am today without the fire service. I had no training and no experience. The fire department offers training and any assistance needed to help jumpstart your career.

A FRIENDLY REMINDER FROM THE FIRE

CHAPTER 370 AND 307 PROHIBITS THE BURNING OF TRASH, RUBBISH, OR YARD WASTE WITHIN THE CITY.

RECREATIONAL FIRES
ARE ALLOWED BUT
SHOULDN'T PRODUCE
NUISANCE SMOKE.

RECREATIONAL FIRES MUST BE KEPT
25 FEET FROM COMBUSTIBLE ITEMS
AND MUST NOT BE LARGER THAN 3
FEET WIDE AND 2 FEET IN HEIGHT

AN EXTINGUISHING AGENT, SUCH AS A GARDEN HOSE OR FIRE EXTINGUISHER MUST BE KEPT IN THE AREA.

DEPARTMENT NEWS CODE ENFORCEMENT

- >>> A REMINDER TO CUT YOUR GRASS!
 - When grass clippings are in the road, they can become slippery, and motorcycle riders could crash if they hit the brakes or turn the wheel.
 - Don't let grass or weeds grow taller than 8 inches!
 - Don't let shrubs, trees, or other vegetation block the sidewalk, and keep trees trimmed at least 7 feet above the sidewalk
 - Leaving grass clippings on the street can pollute rivers with fertilizers and harm wildlife. Excess nitrogen and phosphorus from clippings can lead to algae overgrowth, damaging water quality and habitats. Clippings also clog storm drains, leading to flooding during rain.




