Anyone can join a local fire department. Not only does the fire department allow you to create great friendships, you can a significant amount of knowledge through training. I wouldn't be the person I am today without the fire service. I had no training and no experience. The fire department offers training and any assistance needed to help jumpstart your career.

A FRIENDLY REMINDER FROM THE FIRE COMPANY:

**CHAPTER 370 AND 307 PROHIBITS THE BURNING OF TRASH, RUBBISH, OR YARD
WASTE WITHIN THE CITY.**

RECREATIONAL FIRES
ARE ALLOWED BUT
SHOULDN'T PRODUCE
NUISANCE SMOKE.

RECREATIONAL FIRES MUST BE KEPT
25 FEET FROM COMBUSTIBLE ITEMS
AND MUST NOT BE LARGER THAN 3
FEET WIDE AND 2 FEET IN HEIGHT

AN EXTINGUISHING AGENT,
SUCH AS A GARDEN HOSE
OR FIRE EXTINGUISHER MUST
BE KEPT IN THE AREA.

>>> A REMINDER TO CUT YOUR GRASS!



When grass clippings are in the road, they can become slippery, and motorcycle riders could crash if they hit the brakes or turn the wheel.



Don't let grass or weeds grow taller than 8 inches!



Don't let shrubs, trees, or other vegetation block the sidewalk, and keep trees trimmed at least 7 feet above the sidewalk



Leaving grass clippings on the street can pollute rivers with fertilizers and harm wildlife. Excess nitrogen and phosphorus from clippings can lead to algae overgrowth, damaging water quality and habitats. Clippings also clog storm drains, leading to flooding during rain.

Good neighbors. Better community. Best World.

DON'T FORGET!

It is illegal in Lock Haven to dispose of grass clippings or refuse in streets or alleys, with a fine of up to \$1,000 per offense as per Lock Haven City Code Chapter 273-1.

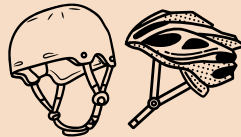

A RECAP ON FIRE SAFETY

With the hot months being in full swing it is more important now than ever to be aware and educated on the correct steps to take in case of a fire emergency. Just doing a few minutes of research could help separate you from a potentially fatal disaster. Below are just a couple examples on how to help maintain your safety, but remember in the event of an emergency do not hesitate to call 9-1-1- so trained professionals can be at your aid! So don't STOP yourself from enjoying your summer and DROP unsafe habits so you can ROLL right into the fun!





FIRE SAFETY TIPS

IN CASE OF FIRE



Stay calm and evacuate immediately.



On opening doors, Check door handle first. If Hot, DO NOT OPEN as the room may already be on fire.



Use the stairs and do not use the elevator in case you are in a buildings.



If there is smoke, get down low, cover your nose and mouth with damp cloth





STOP DROP and ROLL

If your clothes catch fire, STOP, DROP and ROLL to put out the flames



Sound alarm and call for help



Have yourself checked for injuries



Do not return inside your house or building unless authorities deemed it safe



If trapped, stay in the room, signal for help using a bright colored cloth at the window of make noise



Call the Fire Department or 911
